Dr. Long has lectured extensively throughout the world on topics pertaining to acute, chronic and cancer pain as well as legal and regulatory issues involving pain management. Additionally, Dr. Long has multiple publications concerning areas of pain management.

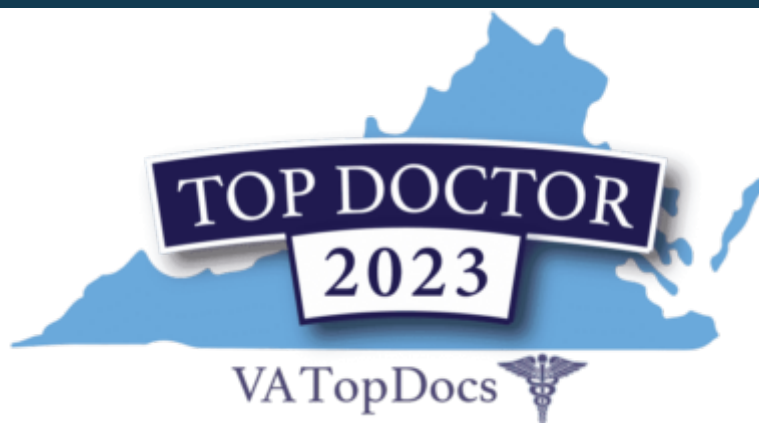

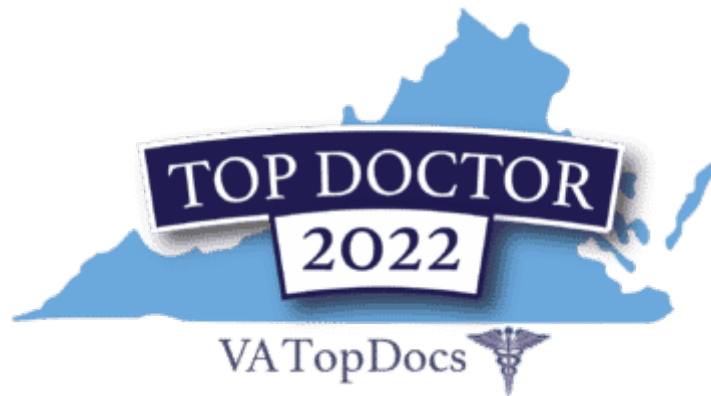
Dr. Stephen P. Long's training and experience have enabled him to provide accurate medical
